From Fish Management: Laura & Tanya

-We've completed our spring fyke netting surveys on Wallace Lake and Big Cedar Lake in Washington County. Preliminary results look good, with many walleyes sampled on Big Cedar.
 -Next we'll be moving on to our spring bass and panfish electrofishing surveys. Lakes on this year's rotation include Big Cedar Lake, Mauthe Lake, and Crooked Lake.
 -Fishing season is officially underway for many species following the May 6th opener. From Wildlife Management: Tanner

- Sheboygan marsh dam project is expected to begin mid-May. The first phase will be removing the
 north half of the dam to drawdown the marsh for construction work. <u>Water levels on the</u>
 <u>Sheboygan Marsh will be extremely low with likely no boat access for 2023 hunting
 season.</u>
- Survey Season has wrapped up for spring waterfowl, woodcock, and pheasant surveys.
- Fire season is active and wrapping up in the next few weeks. Local burns planned include fields at the Sheboygan Marsh, Mullet Creek Wildlife Area and across the Kettle Moraine State Forest.
- Field work is transitioning to woody vegetation spraying, grassland planting, and monitoring water levels in wetlands. Preparation for summer bird banding is beginning as well.
