Wildlife

- New PFAS based consumption advisories are in effect for Green Bay Waterfowl
 - Lower Green Bay (longtail point across to Point Au sable and south)
 - Mallards: Do not eat
 - Upper Green Bay (Northwest of Lower Green Bay zone to Marinette across to Sturgeon Bay)
 - Mallards: 1 meal per month
 - Wood Ducks: 1 meal per week
- CWD Kiosks are out and operational through the end of the Archery season 1/31/26. Locations are as follows
 - Farmstead Archery in Sheboygan
 - Plymouth DNR office
 - KMSF HQ South of Dundee (Kiosk is located on Auburn Road across from the HQ entrance)
 - Old Eden Meat Market in Eden, (Kiosk is located behind the old meat market where people drop off deer)
- 4th CWD positive was found in Sheboygan County in Greenbush. The deer was a 3-year-old doe that died in landowners yard. She exhibited most of the clinical signs of CWD.

Fisheries

- We have been busy in the office getting aging structures collected from Long Lake this spring sectioned and read to examine age and growth of fish in the system.
- With water temperatures cooling, we'll be starting in on our Fall electrofishing surveys on area lakes. These surveys help us assess the number of naturally reproduced walleye and muskellunge that hatched this Spring and survived to their first Fall (young-of-year).
