 - One of the best years in the last 10 due in part to great water clarity and good ice early in the season.
 - Upriver lakes closed on 2/16/2026 and Lake Winnebago is nearing the Adult Female 90% trigger.
- Repairing nets and completing fisheries survey reports from the past sampling season.
